



**Parent Association Meeting Minutes
December 10, 2018
9am – 10:30 am
Mt. Nebo Campus Student Union**

I. Meeting Called to Order

- The meeting was called to order by Vicki Bonzo
- Mrs. Powers opened us in prayer

II. Introductions of New Attendees

III. Budget

- Kristy Sosso from the Wexford campus reported the budget for Jenna LoDico (PA Treasurer) who was unable to attend. Kristy stated that overall the budget is \$1400.00. The Berkeley Hills Christmas shop profited \$344.00.

IV. Berkeley Hills Update – Jodi Brooks

- Wexford and Berkeley will hold the Elementary Father's Bowl on February 10th. The Father's Bowl honors fathers and their children. There are roughly 200 attending. The elementary will use the funds from the Christmas Shop to assist in funding the bowl.

VI. Mt. Nebo Update – Jodi Fleishman

- Mid-term snacks (Mott's fruit snack) will be handed out to all students. The snack will have a scripture verse label on the back.
- The Christmas Bazaar will be held on the last day of mid-terms/school before Christmas break. Debbie Balla, Tara Flinchbaugh, and Amy Rafferty will man the PA table containing spirit wear. Vicki will get the credit card machine.
- PA will provide cookies for the Christmas Concert on Dec. 19th. Vicki will get the cookies and tablecloth ready. She will check with Jana Snavey regarding the number of cookies that will be needed. Amy Rafferty will man the table and cleanup after. Any extra cookies left over will be out for the Bazaar the next day.

VII. Review of Recent Events

- **Staff Luncheons**
Vicki indicated that the fall luncheons went great. There is a need for help with the Spring luncheons. The current parents are Senior parents who will need to hand the reigns over.

VIII. Upcoming Events

- **Christmas Concert**
The Christmas Concert for both elementary campuses will be tomorrow at 7:00pm at Christ Church at Grove Farm. There will be no cookie table due to the Art Show which will be a fundraiser for both campuses. Mount Nebo will hold their concert on December 19th at 7:00pm. The concert will have both the band and the chorus together. There will be a cookie table.
- **Mid-term Encouraging Handouts**
We used money out of the PA fund to purchase Mott's fruit snacks to be handed out to all students at the Mt. Nebo campus for mid-terms. The snacks will contain a scripture verse label on the back and will be handed out on the first day of mid-terms. Debbie Balla suggested a non-chewy snack and it was decided that pencils will be handed out as an alternative. Debbie will get the pencils from Mrs. Powers who indicated she has extras.
- **The Christmas Bazaar/Christmas Shops**
The Christmas Bazaar will be held at the MN Campus on Dec. 20th from 11:20-1:00. PA will again sell spirit wear during the Bazaar. New spirit wear was ordered and will need to be priced to sell.
- **T-shirt Giveaways**
Berkeley Hills gave their t-shirts away during Family Night. Mrs. Powers said the Wexford campus will do the same as the Berkeley campus and give the t-shirts out during Family Night. Mr. Aiken has approved the t-shirts to be given out at the Mt. Nebo campus but there is still ongoing discussion as to when and where.
- **The All School Skate**
The All School Skate is being planned for January 2nd from 11:30-1:30. It will be at the Lemieux Sports Complex. The price will be \$8.00 per person and will include hot chocolate provided by the Lemieux Sports Complex. The PA will provide donut holes.

The next meeting for the Gala will occur sometime after the New Year. Christie Wilcox indicated that the Auction Committee needs help and items for the auction.
