# VIII. Upcoming Events

## Family Night

### • Christmas Concert

The next gala meeting will be held sometime in the beginning of January. Summer will send out the date as soon as it is determined.

## Ambassador Program

Michelle Rice is heading this up and would like someone from the PA to step up in this role next year. Amy Piemme is meeting with Michelle to discuss stepping into that role. There will be two programs including a "Summer Program" and an "All Year Program." The need is for one person from each campus to be the coordinator for the Summer Program and a different person to be the coordinator for the All Year Program. The Summer Program coordinator will have one family who is involved with ECA to host a gathering (gender specific) over the summer. The All Year Program coordinator will need to pair buddies for new students. There is a need for all grades for all new families. There will also need to be a separate parent for each grade and each campus to choose doing either the Summer Program or the All Year Program. Amy Piemme has volunteered to be the coordinator for the Berkeley Campus (but has not yet chosen the Summer or All Year). There is still one more coordinator needed for the Berkeley campus and both Summer and All Year coordinators needed at Wexford and MN. Michelle will stay involved with the Ambassador Program and will help out.
